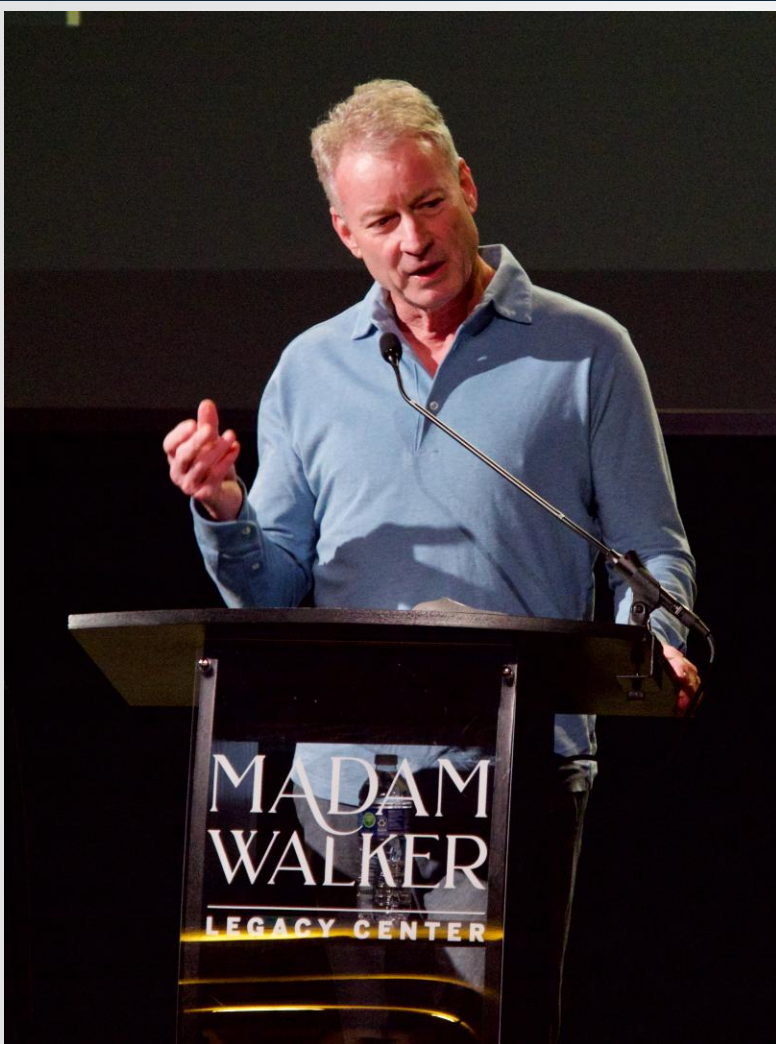

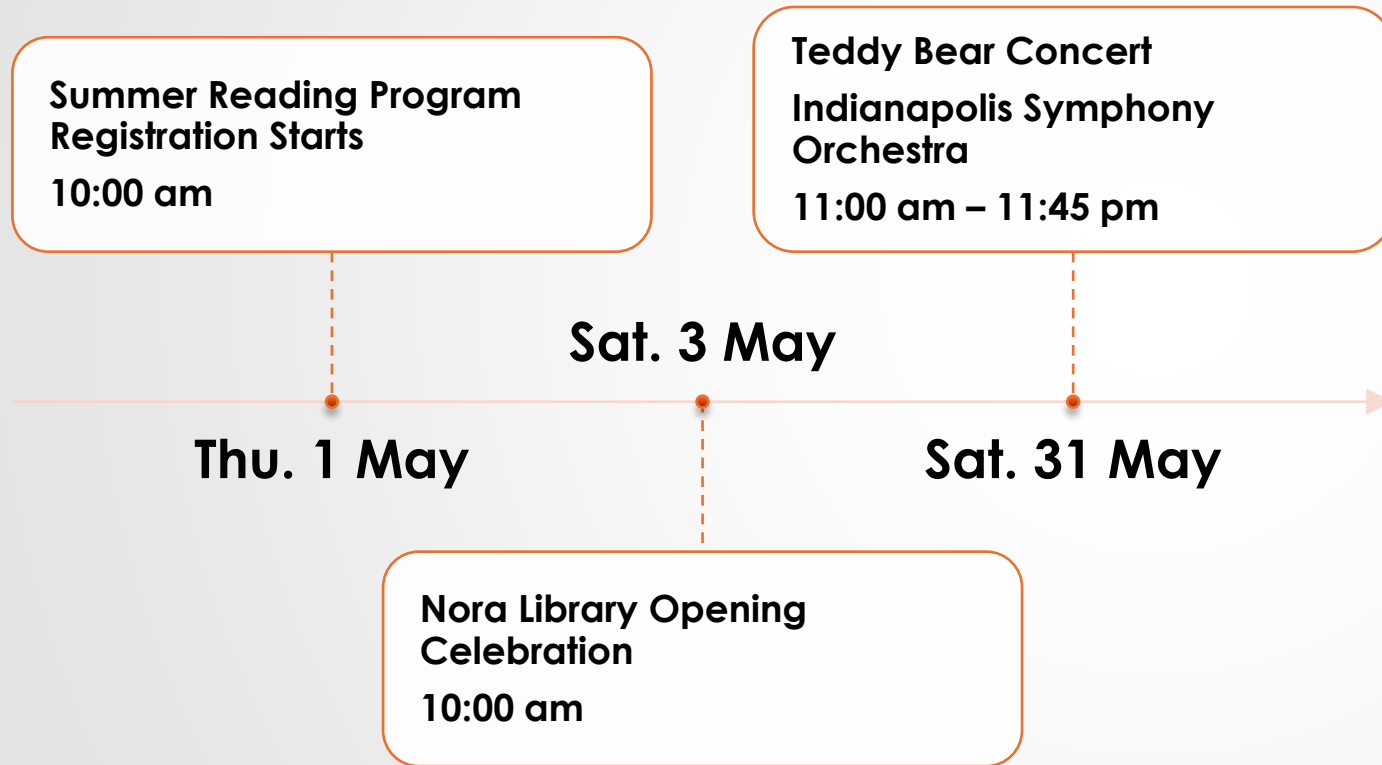
The Library hosted 303 adult and 607 youth programs in March, welcoming 17,677 visitors to our locations.
